Goring Brut – England	39.95
This stunning English wine is made by award winning winemaker Dermot Sugrue in West Sussex. A fantastic blend of chardonnay, pinot noir and pinot meunier this wine has a full flavour of crumbly shortbread biscuit with a creamy hint of vanilla. As good as any Champagne #amazing! (12% ABV)	
Champagne Moutard Grande Cuvee - France	42.00
The House of Moutard is a small & exclusive champagne producer. The Moutard family have been making Champagne in the small village of Buxeuil for the past four centuries. This deliciously smooth tasting champagne made from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay is perfectly crisp and refreshing. (12% ABV)	
Moutard Rosé, Champagne – France	46.95
Champagne Moutard Prestige Rose NV is made from 100% pinot noir. This wine is a beautiful salmon pink colour with delicate bubbles. A delightful pink champagne with lovely summer fruit flavours and a richness and complexity that you would expect from a top grower. Perfect for summer drinking but great at any time! (12% ABV)	
Bollinger Special Cuvee – France	65.00
One of the best known Champagne houses, the Special Cuvee is an expression of the Bollinger house style. This weighty, full style is rich on the palate and long on the finish but it has elegance too – definitely a big personality. A rich, biscuity nose with a hint of summer fruits. On the palate, full flavours of nuts, toast and some citrus characters abound, balanced by excellent acidity. (12% ABV)

Swartland Bushvine Chenin – South Africa				25.95
We were slightly dubious when our supplier told us how amazing this top Chenin Blanc was until we actually opened it! Complex and fruity with a long creamy aftertaste, this South African wine demonstrates how versatile one grape can be. The old vines of the Swartland winery have done it again with this very special Chenin (13.5%)				
Hen & Chicken Chardonnay – Australia				30.50
Chardonnay doesn't get much bigger than this! If you like big complex whites you will love this. Aged in French oak barrels it's rich & buttery so you won't know whether to eat it or drink it! The wine shows aromas of citrus and melon, with a soft yet intense palate bursting with flavours of lemon butter and gentle spice. (13% ABV)
